

NON-THESIS MASTER OF SCIENCE IN ECOLOGY, EVOLUTIONARY, AND POPULATION BIOLOGY

Requirements: Thirty credit hours, including a minimum of twenty-two credit hours in primary area courses (500 level or above), are required for a non-thesis M.S. in Ecology, Evolutionary and Population Biology. A maximum of eight research credit hours (BIOL 595R, BIOL 695R) can be taken to fulfill the 30 credit requirement. An average grade of B must be obtained; no grade of less than C may be counted towards the thirty credit hours for 500 and 600-level courses. A minimum grade of B is required for 400-level courses.
